


# **Unit 3** – Melodies Using C and D

The note D is written in the space under the staff and uses the second finger on the right hand.





### Two Note Cha-Cha








This is a three beat note. It's called a dotted minim. A dot after a note makes the note longer by half its value.

## <u>Italian Terms</u>

<u>Legato</u> When you play, join the different notes smoothly

together. This is called Legato.

Staccato When you play, make the notes short and

detached. This is called Staccato.


